


We are very thankful to the Shavurov-Nguyen family for their generous gift. This valuable book collection will hold a special place in our school library!



PRESCHOOL 1

This week the students of Preschool 1 have been busy learning about arctic animals. We watched a short educational video about arctic animals. We discussed what kinds of animals live in the Arctic. Our children pulled out a picture of an arctic animal and named it. To remember the name of the arctic animals, we played a game to guess what you see. We discussed that arctic animals live in cold places and what can help the animal to survive. During our art activity, we drew the Polar Bear, the Penguin and other inhabitants of the Arctic. On Friday, we simulated and showed a snowstorm in a jar, our children really enjoyed watching the snowstorm. Then we gave two different containers of snow and frozen ice cubes to our friends, after which the friends tried to play with them, but they couldn't play for long. Now we know that it is quite cold in Arctic places. Next week we will start talking about the animals that live in the jungle.
