Strategies to deal with the loss and grief during transitions

Experiencing changes and saying goodbye is the normality of globally mobile families – some leave after 2 years, others after 3, 4 or more years in a country. Even if they are not the ones leaving, in the international school system, somebody is always leaving – friends, peers, teachers. An important aspect of processing grief and loss is the awareness and permission of it. Supporting our children in dealing with the normal emotions during transitions will benefit their resilience and mental health.

We are pleased to invite our community to attend an online talk about transition (via Zoom) with guest speaker and proud Taigan alumni mum Katja Aegerter (MSc in Psychology, PhD Candidate). Learn about the essentials of Third Culture Kids, their grief and loss, and exchange experiences with others. The talk will take place on Wednesday 11th May at 5.30pm, lasting around an hour. During this session, Katja will give a presentation about supporting your child through transition, and there will be time for questions, sharing experiences and connecting with others.
