



PRESCHOOL 1

This week, Preschool 1 friends finished their final unit "We Share the Planet" by learning about the topic of "Recycling". Our friends became aware that we can make some new things out of used items, and we called it recycling.

We discussed the importance of taking care of our planet, and our friends learned that plastic isn't good for our planet. If we throw plastic or other trash, our planet and its living things will be sad. To take action, we collected used plastic bottles, and our little friends used them to water the plants in our garden. The children also went on a scavenger hunt to find

different types of recyclable items and sorted all used things into plastic, paper, and compost by putting them into 3 different recycling bins.

In our UOI lesson, we talked about reusing and friends explained what the word 'reuse' means. In Art, they made paper cup watches by reusing plastic coffee cups as a way of reducing pollution.

In English, our Preschool 3 friends learnt about the phonic sound "Y" and identified objects in the classroom that began with the sound 'y', such as a yoyo and a yellow tray. They also counted to see how

many friends had yellow clothes on. They then read words like 'yak and yoyo' and drew pictures. In Math, our friends counted from number 1 to 25.

Our Preschool 3 friends have learnt to be caring and patient with each other. They play well together and share their toys at the same time helping each other complete given tasks. They also read in pairs and assist each other when they encounter new words.
