ECA AND MUSIC ACADEMY TERM 1 SIGN-UP

ECAs and Music Academy lessons start on Monday, 28th August, and finish on Friday, 13th October.

ECA and Music Academy Sign-up start on SchoolsBuddy on Wednesday, 23th August and finish on Friday, 25th August.

All information regarding ECA and Music Academy including the ECA list for Term 1 will be sent out to the BIS community on Monday, 21st August.



Thursday 31st August is a public holiday and school will not be open on that day. Normal school (including ECAs) will resume on Friday 1st September.

ECA sign-up will be a preference-system, meaning that parents will select first, second and third choice for each child on each day, and the system will automatically allocate ECAs fairly and objectively to each student based on preferences and the number of spaces available. This means that there is no need to rush to sign up as soon as it opens, meaning it is a much more convenient process for you.

Music Academy sign-up will be on a first-come-first-serve basis, so in order to have the best chance to sign up for lessons which are convenient for you, please sign up as soon as possible after sign-up opens.

SCHOOL BUS



School buses operate from Monday August 21st.

Morning buses arrive at the school around 7:45. Afternoon buses leave at 15:20 and 16:40. Please make clear which afternoon bus option you require.

The bus costs 150 som per journey.

ARRIVING BY CAR



If you deliver children to school by car, please avoid congestion near the school gates.

Entry to the drop-off area for school buses is only allowed for cars with Preschool and Grade 0-1 students as space is very limited.

Please follow directions from our security guards to keep the area around school safe for children!
