# **BASELINE ENGLISH LANGUAGE TESTS IN PRIMARY SCHOOL**

The Primary school will have baseline English Language tests in the third week of the school year. Grade 2&4 on September 4th, Grade 1&3 on September 5th, and Grade 5 on September 6th. We will do catch up tests on September 7th and 8th for those students who missed on earlier. Students do not need specific preparation for these baseline tests which are designed to help teachers understand their students' abilities. Our focus is Reading Comprehension from Grades 2-4. Grade 5 will also have a Grammar assessment. First graders will be assessed based on Phonics.




English baseline tests will happen three times during the school year: in September, January, and April. The results will be used throughout the year to see how well students are doing and to adjust teaching strategies as needed. The baseline test results and the progress made by the child will be reflected in their reports as a way to understand and celebrate student's progress. Teachers will share learning strategies with families to target learning goals. We appreciate the learning community support and efforts to develop speaking, reading and
