MYP STUDENTS' CREATIVE JOURNEY

MYP students turned a piece of tissue into a master piece. They enjoyed this experimental art process so much. And now they can transform anything into a stunning art work.

















MAKING A ZOETROPE

Grade 0 has been learning about senses and how they help to explore the world around us.

Students have been talking about how different things feel, smell, taste, sound and look. The children took part in activity based learning that encouraged investigation, exploration and how motion can create the illusion of movement. A zoetrope tricks the sense of sight by displaying a sequence of drawings showing progressive

phases of motion, viewed through a cylinder with slits.

Students used their fine motor skills to cut replaceable cartoon strips, and their problem solving skills to build the cylinder. A slim stick was poked through the bottom in order to balance, hold and spin the zoetrope.








And behold, their project was complete, with the fascinating results of a dog seemingly catching a butterfly, as well as a man skipping and running.
