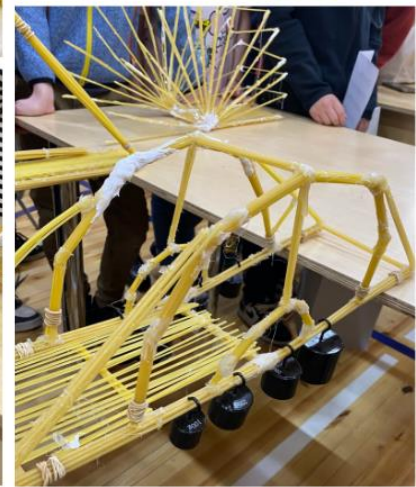




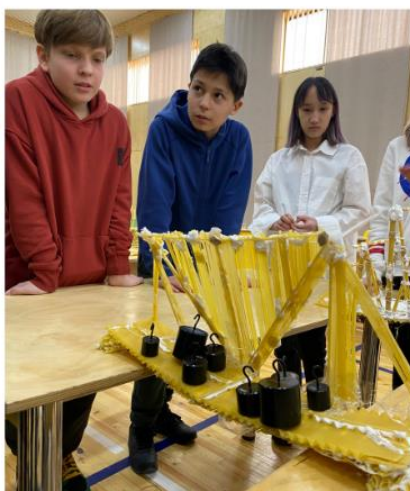
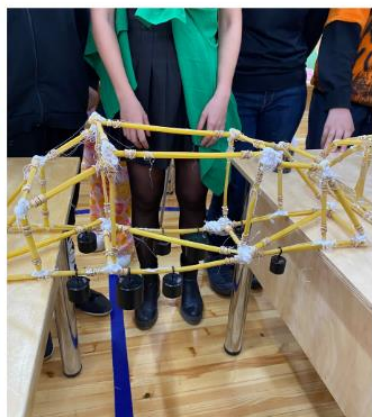
# SPAGHETTI BRIDGE



Grade 7 students participated in an interdisciplinary project where they built bridges using only spaghetti and hot glue. This project combined science, mathematics, and design courses which allowed students to exercise their problem-solving and critical thinking abilities while also applying their creativity and research skills to construct visually appealing and functional bridges.



The project provided an opportunity for students to learn about interdisciplinary thinking, collaboration, and gain hands-on experience with essential skills such as design thinking. Overall, it was an engaging, enriching and joyful learning experience for the students.



## BAKING BREAD



As part of our Unit of Inquiry, “How the World Works,” students discovered how to make braided bread. Firstly, they learnt about the ingredients to make the dough – water, flour, yeast, eggs, honey and sunflower oil. This made them aware of what often goes into this staple food, something which many eat on a daily basis. The dough kept ‘magically’ rising in front of them, even though no one touched it. The children learned that this was because the yeast ate the sugar in the flour and expelled carbon dioxide gas in the process.

Prior to making the bread, students had learnt various mathematical concepts and knowledge desired for this activity. The children studied grams and kilograms, needed to weigh ingredients, as well as estimation and division, required for the amount of communal dough students would divide among themselves. The children kneaded and rolled the mixture and baked their own handmade loaf each. It helped them make connections between subjects such as science and maths. Literacy and community also merged in this activity. The braids represent the joining together of family and friends. The BIS community came to help, with Ms. Erkinai, Ms. Michaela, Ms. Nazira A., Ms Altynai and Ms. Kanykei all playing a part in the students’ successful completion of their bread. The students ate a honey flavoured and pillowy-soft bread, and using procedural writing, they wrote about it. The sweet smell of the bread baking in the oven was matched by the students’ success. And they had a hands-on, fun experience.
