GOVERNING BOARD DECISIONS

On Thursday, January 18th, 2024, the BIS Governing Board (GB) gathered for its second meeting of the academic year, delving into critical matters shaping BIS strategy, policy and governance. The GB welcomed Alex Straus as a new member, elected by the Advisory Council to join the Governing Board.

One of the primary focal points of the meeting was the exploration of land options for a new large campus. The Governing Board examined various factors, including financial feasibility and strategic alignment. The GB turned its attention to the Management Board Report for the month of December, the thorough review provided the board with insights into the current state of the BIS, ensuring informed decisions on areas for attention and improvement. In a bid to uphold and strengthen academic integrity, the Governing Board reviewed and approved amendments to key school policies: the Academic Honesty Policy, Assessment Policy, and the Student Handbook. The Governing Board also agreed to have no fee increase for the 2023/24 Academic Year, despite significant inflation in the country over the last two years
