Middle School Science Teacher

ROLES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Teaching

- Develop, deliver, and assess general science teaching in the IB Middle Years Programme for Grade 6-8 (as required, according to student needs and teacher allocations). Note that this is the essential requirement for the 2024/25 Academic Year.
- 2. Develop, deliver, and assess specialist science teaching in the Cambridge IGCSE Programme and the IB Diploma Programme for Grade 9-12 (as required, according to student needs and teacher allocations). Note that this is not planned for the 2024/25 Academic Year.
- 3. Align classroom learning and teaching to programme approaches and grade level requirements.
- 4. Create an engaging classroom environment that motivates students to learn and ensure all student expectations are high.
- 5. Provide a positive learning environment for each student and inspire students to expand their understanding and enjoyment of the subjects taught.
- 6. Differentiate instruction to meet the individual needs of each student to be socially and academically successful, having regard to the abilities and aptitudes of individuals.
- 7. Enhance lessons through incorporating technology into the teaching program and be creative in working with limited resources.
- 8. Use a wide range of assessment methods to ensure student knowledge and understanding are appropriately recorded.
- 9. Provide individual tutoring for students who need support to progress in their course (as required, according to student needs and teacher allocations).
- 10. Be an exemplary teacher, clearly demonstrating effective planning, teaching and organization, and high standards of achievement and behaviour in lessons.
- 11. Collaborate with other teachers to ensure a consistent approach to learning and achievement of standards for each group.
- 12. Work with Programme Coordinators to produce relevant planning documents and attend relevant Programme meetings.
- 13. Plan, keep and report appropriate records to school management and parents.

Co-Form Teacher for one grade level in Middle School

1. Responsibilities as Co-Form Teacher, together with another teacher for one grade level in High School, including responsibility for:

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- Student integration in the school, understanding the education process and the curriculum
- o Student attendance and behaviour
- Student social development, including group dynamics and teamwork, and an annual overnight trip
- o Coordination between specialist subject teachers for this group or individual students
- Academic reports for the students

Other Responsibilities

- 1. Supervise Extended Essay Students for the IB Diploma (as required, according to student needs and teacher allocations).
- 2. Supervise relevant Community Service and CAS projects for High School students (as required, according to student needs and teacher allocations).
- 3. Organise and lead extra-curricular activities and student engagement to promote positive interactions among students of all ages and develop their academic, creative and sporting potential.

General

- 1. Maintain knowledge of current educational theory and practice and undertake professional training in liaison with the Head of Department.
- 2. Act in accordance with the budgets, policies, procedures, directions and decisions of the school management
- 3. Act as ambassador for the school and act in a manner that upholds the values and ethos of the school at all times
- 4. Maintain high quality standards in all areas of the school
- 5. Any other activities as agreed with management to contribute to overall development of the school.
