There has also been a rumour about the possible raise of grade boundaries for the M24 session. Some of our G12 students were panicking and seemed to have spent some amount of time trying to learn more about the leak.

Despite the distractions this caused it is always good to remind ourselves of the classical TOK question "How do we know?" and then focus on our own exams while leaving the leak investigation job to the IB. It is always best to keep calm and patiently wait for the latest official information until the results come out.


The bomb threat at the Manas Airport just before the final day of the IB examinations also created some tension for invigilators, but fortunately our school did not receive any threats.
